SCC FURTHER EDUCATION SONGWRITING COMPETITION 2020

RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. All participants must be fulltime students attending further education courses at City of Dublin ETB colleges / centres. College contact teachers will be asked to verify that songwriters/ performers are full time CDETb students in their college.
2. Applicants must submit an original song as indicated on the SCC website by the **Thursday 6th February 2020** deadline.
3. The music may be in any genre, although the format is acoustic, and designed to be performed by a maximum of two performers.
4. Songs may be co-written.
5. Songs will be shortlisted by an independent panel.
6. The shortlisted songs will be performed at an event **Workmans' Club**, 10 Wellington Quay, Temple Bar Dublin, D02 VX36 on **Wednesday 12th February 2020**. At the event, songwriters may nominate other musicians to perform their song, although these students must be verified as full time CDETb students.
7. It is assumed that the applicant(s) is/are the copyright holder of the song.
8. **Participants at the event must be over 18.**
9. The judges' decision is final
10. Organisation of the event is the sole prerogative of the Music Sub-Committee
11. All participants are governed by SCC's General regulations
